## Slime in a Jar Recipe

I/4 cup of water
I cup of liquid glue
4 tablespoons of saline solution
I/2 teaspoon of baking soda
few drops of food coloring
glitter optional



## **Directions**

Add I/4 cup of water, I cup of liquid glue, 4 tablespoons of saline solution, I/2 teaspoon of baking soda, and a few drops of food coloring to your jar.

Tip: A wide mouth jar will make it easier to remove your slime at the end.

Add glitter as well, if desired.

Fasten the lid firmly on your jar.

Shake until all your ingredients are combined and start to pull away from the sides of your jar (about 30 - 60 seconds).

Now it's time to play! Remove the lid from your jar, take out your slime, and add in a few small figurines, gems, or cookie cutters.
